

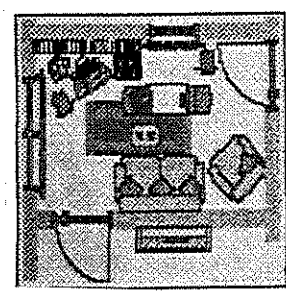
Das Haus meiner Träume



Most Americans have visions of a "house of dreams." The average German could not hope to own his or her own home. With over 80 million people in a country the size of Montana, land is at a premium. Many cities are crowded, and the *Wohnung* (apartment) is a way of life. *Das Haus im Grünen ist ein Traum*, and it remains only a dream for most.

Your task is to work with a partner and design a floor plan for your *Haus* or *Wohnung* that shows the layout of the different rooms. Design a plan for each floor (*der Stock*) of a house, or a complete set of rooms for a *Wohnung*. If you really enjoy this, add some landscaping that would make this a true "*Haus meiner Träume*." When you have the plan finished, label all the rooms and objects in the rooms *auf Deutsch* (the main part of your project). When labeling your house, you need to look up 5 new words in a dictionary and label those correctly as well.

Finally, you will describe your dream house to your teacher. Using *Deutsch*, give an oral "tour" of the house's different rooms (name the rooms, use describing words for the room and objects in the room and use prepositions) We will eventually have a tour of homes, where you can see your classmates' designs.
