

U-Bahn und S-Bahn Plan (2011)

1. To get to the *Frauenkirche* you need to get off at *Marienplatz*. What *S-Bahn* (7) and *U-Bahn* (2) lines could you take to get there? You don't need to list end stations...yet.

2. The BMW plant is located near the *Petuelring*. What *U-Bahn* line do you need to take to get there from the *Fußgängerzone*? What is the *Richtung* (end station) of the line?

3. You would like to go see the monument *Feldherrnhalle*. You need to get off at the station *Odeonsplatz*. There are 4 *U-Bahn* trains that go that way. If you start at the *Fußgängerzone* which *U-Bahn* trains (include end station) could you take?

4. You are in the mood for some animal watching. Visit the zoo. One *U-Bahn* line will take you there from the *Fußgängerzone*. What is the end station?

5. You would like to check out the famous concentration camp Dachau. You can take only one *S-Bahn* line to get there from the *Fußgängerzone*. Which one is it and what is the end station? (hint it is on the top left side of your map)

6. After seeing the depressing sight at Dachau you are excited to rest and relax while listening to music at the *Englischer Garten* exit *Universität*. What route would you take to get from *Dachau* to *Universität*? Where would you switch trains? What are your end stations?

7. You are excited to see the home of the 1972 Olympics. Take this one *U-Bahn* line to get there from the *Fußgängerzone*. What is the end station?

8. You just flew into Munich and are excited to check out the monument to Herzog Otto I v. Wittelsbach. You know an Otto and you just have to see if they look alike. How would you get to *Odeonsplatz* where the *Denkmal* (monument) is from the airport? What lines and what end stations? (notice you will need to switch trains, tell me where)
