

## Project Guidelines

- ✓ You are to have a weeklong trip to Munich. When planning you may use the first and last day just for travel. Each day you are to create a realistic plan incorporating all you would like to see in the week. You may use any of my packets to help you or you may just use the Internet.
- ✓ First, you will need to plan the perfect time to go to Munich. It may be tomorrow or during a break or during school.
- ✓ I want you also to find at least two planned restaurants to eat at throughout the week. You may add them to the plan however you would like. Make sure they are close to the places you are visiting that day. They may not be located in your hotel.
- ✓ Make sure you tally all of your costs for each day. If there are not costs listed guess a number and give yourself a budget.
- ✓ Your final project must be easy to read and to look nice.
  - ◆ Remember when creating your plan to see things close together each day and it is probably only possible to visit one or two museums a day. For example, it would not be possible to visit the Deutsches Museum and Neuschwanstein in the same day.
  - ◆ You may not spend an entire day at any of the drinking locations, but you may stop by to see what they are.
  - ◆ You may do *one* organized or themed tour, but it cannot last longer than one day. An organized or themed tour visits many different locations during the tour. You may have as many individual tours as you wish.
  - ◆ Remember to tell me where everything is. (a map is a good idea)
  - ◆ You must be kept busy. I would suggest doing 2 or more major things a day. more if they are just buildings to see. Hanging out in the hotel for a day does not count. Visiting museums takes about a half day, visiting churches or monuments about an hour.
